
There is a separate collection basket in the narthex for any who would like to place a communion offering that goes towards the Bereavement Fund.





Epworth Children's Home - MAKALA'S STORY:

Makala is one of Epworth's success stories. Under the direction of her case manager Ms. Wolfe, Makala learned that having just own person to believe in you and cheer you on can make all the difference. This is one of the things children get while being at Epworth. Makala's time at Epworth Children's Home helped her transition to life in college. It taught her the life skills to help her to adjust to college life. She was able to get financial aid on her own, do her own laundry and chores, schedule her time wisely, and manage her money. She maintained her big dreams and a work ethic of gold at the University of South Carolina. While many other children struggled being on their own for the first time, Makala thrived. Makala now comes back to Epworth as an intern where she works directly with children and teens. She reminds the teens that no matter how angry you are or how badly life has treated them, they can do hard things, succeed, and write their own story— just like Ms. Wolfe taught her years ago. Makala also reminds us that you can make your own family wherever you go.
