Dolls, balls (include manual air pump if necessary), stuffed animals, nail clippers and files, small musical instrument (harmonica, woodwind recorder, etc), pencils, pencil sharpeners, colored pencils, pencil cases, glue sticks (not liquid glue), watercolor sets, stickers, underwear, shoes and socks, flip-flops, sunglasses, slinky, small kite, finger puppets, washcloth, toothbrushes, yo-yo's, combs & hair brushes, lip balm, backpacks, chalk and chalkboards, crayons, coloring books, notebooks, flashlight (include extra batteries, hair bows, tote bags, purses, puzzles, calculators, playing cards, jump ropes, stick deodorant, bandanas, etc..

give as you are able! *Thank You!*

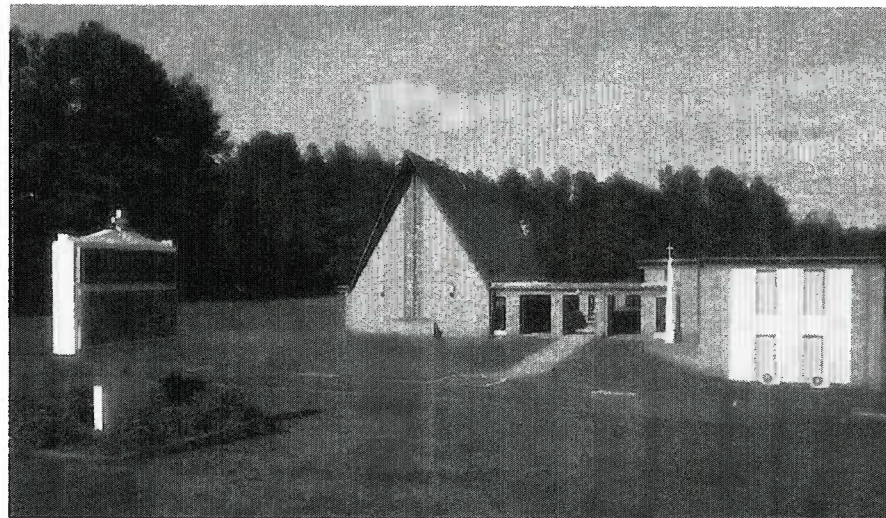
