and Hot Dog Fundraiser!!

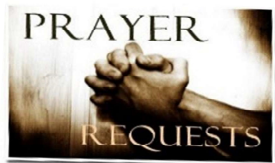

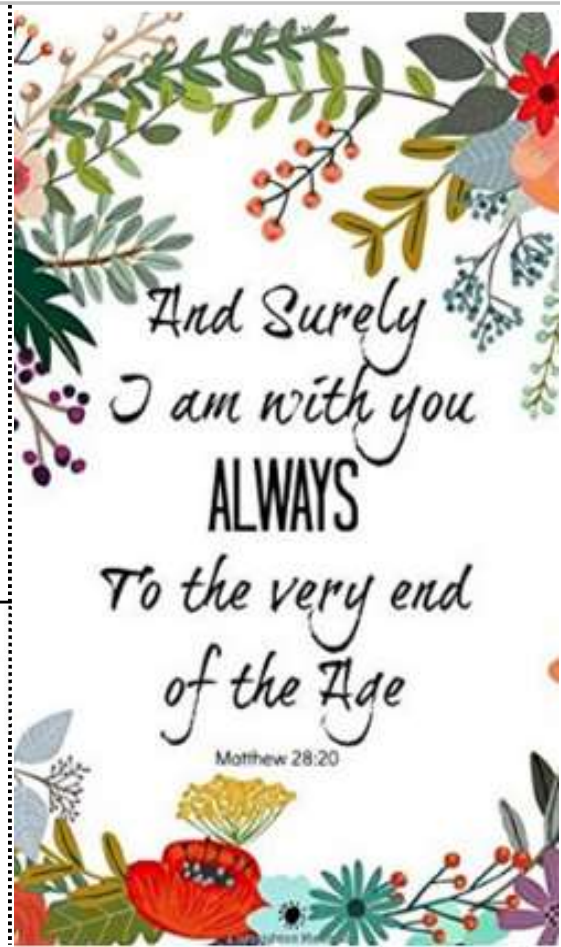
